### Things you need to know:

# Serve Saegertown 2012

## The Basics:

Local participants, will sleep at their homes. Groups coming in will be assigned homes from people in the local churches or will sleep and shower in the local school.

It is preferred for all incoming groups, that the ration of adults to youth be kept to around 1 to 5 if possible.

Leaders must be over 21. If your group has both male and female, your must have both male and female leaders.

## Qualification for Serve Saegertown:

- Youth entering into 7<sup>th</sup> grade or above.
- Youth and Leaders must submit in advance: <sup>1</sup>)Application form  
<sup>2</sup>)Pastor's referral and <sup>3</sup>)Fee payment.
- Leaders must have valid driver's license

Teams receive assignments & lunch
- 9:15am – leave for destinations
- 12:00pm – lunch on site
- 4:00pm – Prepare to Return
- 5:00-6:00pm – Free Time / activity
- 6:00pm – Supper
- 7:00pm - Evening project / activity
- 9:00pm - pm Gathering
- 11:00pm - lights out
